



The visionary who foreseen the economical, social and environmental changes has bought and preserved the land for the future where it could become the biggest source of strength for YMCA to sustain in the competitive world. The idea is to build a 100 bedded orphan home in that open land therefore he invested all his reputation by inviting the Iconic Indian cricket players like Kapil Dev, Ravi Shastri, Maninder Singh and others who joined their hands in raising the required funds to build the desired project.

The project stood a role model for many such organizations for decades, But in the due course of time, due to the negligence and improper administration of the successors or the then management the project has to wind up. Later the campus was guarded by 2 or 3 watchmen. But suddenly the things started falling apart, people with evil intentions started crouching to grab the good of YMCA instead of protecting and preserving. This is how the war between the saviours and devourers began. Nevertheless we being the approved board functioning from YMCA Secunderabad took the upper hand over the culprits. With the collective help of members and well wishers now the issue is almost at the verge of resolving state.
